Any person desiring to take the <u>Saturday, March 29, 2025</u> Navajo Nation Bar Examination must submit a <u>complete</u> application and a non-refundable application fee of \$150.00 to the Office of the Navajo Nation Bar Association, Inc. (NNBA). The completed application and non-refundable application fee may be: (1) mailed to the NNBA at Post Office Box 690, Window Rock, Navajo Nation (AZ) 86515; or (2) hand-delivered to the NNBA located at the Karigan Professional Complex, Suite 116A, 100 Mt. Taylor Rd., Hwy 264, St. Michaels, Arizona. <u>The completed application and \$150.00 application fee</u> must be received by the NNBA on or before Friday, January 31, 2025.

Give specific answers to each part of every question on the application. Do not leave any spaces blank. If the question is not applicable to you, write "N/A" in the space provided for the answer. When attaching additional pages or documents to supplement an answer, identify the question that is being supplemented and provide the information in the same manner as called for in the application.

A complete application consists of the following forms and documents, <u>all of which must be completed</u>, <u>signed and notarized</u>, as applicable. Note: Different information and documents are required for different applicants. Applicants are responsible for reviewing the NNBA Bylaws, as amended, for admission requirements.

- 1. <u>Petitioner's Application</u> (**Form A**, to be completed by applicant).
- 2. <u>Petitioner's Affidavit</u> (**Form B**, to be completed by applicant and notarized).
- 3. <u>Three letters of recommendation</u>, one of which must be submitted by a current member of the NNBA (**Form C**).
- 4. <u>Official certificate of graduation</u> or other certified proof of completion of a JD from a law school accredited by the American Bar Association, if applicable.
- 5. <u>Official certificate or other certified proof</u> of completion of a paralegal training program, advocacy program, apprenticeship program, or equivalent, which is approved by the NNBA Training Committee, if applicable.
- 6. <u>Official certificate of graduation</u> or other certified proof of completion of a bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year institution, if applicable.
- 7. <u>Authorization and Release</u> (**Form D**, to be completed, notarized and sent by the applicant to the respective bar associations of which applicant is a member or is an applicant for admission).
- 8. <u>Character and Fitness Report(s)</u>, if applicable (**Form E**, to be completed by all bar associations of which applicant is a member or is an applicant for admission, which must be received by the

- NNBA by 5:00 p.m. (MDT), Friday, January 31, 2025.) (Applicant must sent Form E, together with a completed Form D (Authorization and Release), to the respective bar association(s).
- 9. Employment Reference Confirmation (Form F). Applicant must fill in his or her name and send the Employment Reference Confirmation form, together with a completed Form D (Authorization and Release), to all current and prior employers for the past five (5) years. Completed and signed forms must be received by the NNBA on or before 5:00 p.m. (MDT), Friday, January 31, 2025.
- 10. NNBA-Approved Traditional Teachings and Navajo Culture Course Certificate of Completion. The Certificate of Completion must be received by the NNBA at least ten (10) business days prior to the applicant being sworn in as a member of the NNBA. The applicant is responsible for all course fees and registration requirements.
- 11. <u>Proof of enrollment</u> in a federally recognized Indian tribe of the United States, if applicable.

Applicants who are not enrolled members of a federally recognized Indian tribe of the United States and are not yet members in good standing of a bar in any state jurisdiction are required to take a state bar examination prior to taking the Navajo Nation Bar Examination. If the applicant has registered to take a state bar examination and ultimately does not take the examination, he or she must immediately notify the NNBA of the change and will not be permitted to take the Navajo Nation Bar Examination. If the applicant does not pass the state bar examination, he or she will not be admitted to the NNBA. If permitted to take the NNBA Bar Exam pursuant to Section IV.B.i of the NNBA Bylaws, the applicant must pass the state bar examination, and must be admitted to practice by such state bar to be eligible for admission to membership in the NNBA. See NNBA Bylaws, Section VI.C.

If the applicant fails to submit the non-refundable \$150.00 application fee or any of the required documentation so that they are not received in the NNBA office by 5:00 p.m. (MDT), Friday, January 31, 2025, his or her application will be deemed incomplete and the application will be denied. It is the applicant's responsibility to know the admission requirements and to submit a complete application, supporting documentation and application fee in a timely manner. Neither the NNBA nor any of its employees or representatives are responsible for assisting the applicant in the preparation or submission of his or her application.

All applications and supporting documentation submitted to the NNBA become the property of the NNBA. The \$150.00 application fee is non-refundable and will not be applied toward future applications. The applicant must submit a new application, supporting documentation and application fee for each examination.
